#### POLICE

FIRE	Chief Jonathan Armstrong reported the Statistics of the Fire Department since the last Council meeting. He also stated that he is attending Chief Officer Classes at the Fire Academy. FINANCIAL	Finance Director Phillip Dye reported that the sales tax revenue for this month is \$120,682.18, which is the highest it has ever been.
CITY MANAGER REPORT	City Manager Hellyn Riggins reported that our judge has still not been able to make it to court. Farmers Market had its last day on August 7. Many thanks to James Curlee for once again being the Market Master. The trees in front of the bank building have been cut down, and sign permits have been issued to APEX Bank. There is a small gas leak on Allisona Road next to City Hall. HHUD says the area is safe and repairs should happen soon.City Manager will be attending a Risk and Insurance Symposium this week. There is a meeting set with the architect for Friday to go over final plans and updates. The city has purchased a new road-worthy Polaris 4 seater with a bed. It should be in in October.
PENDING PROJECTS	City Manager Hellyn Riggins stated that she is working on the following projects: Christmas lights for City Hall, street banners, new park sign, a new City Seal, ongoing building permits, Fall Festival, Tree lighting.
PLANNING & CODES	City Manager Hellyn Riggins reported that the Planning Commission met and approved the signs for APEX Bank, the site plan for Eagleville Grocery, and the grading site plan for Shane Fogel.
