b. <u>Discussion of Ordinance 2022-003 to be Drafted Creating Specific Design Regulations for 742 Webb Road AKA Stephenson Farms AKA Parcel 141-001.00-000. (Ordinance 2022-03 to be renumbered.)</u>

City Manager, Hellyn Riggins stated that because we have moved on to a new calendar year, the ordinance will be renumbered to reflect that. She stated the developer has brought in their new restrictive covenants for the commission's review. As they were received today, we will take the next month to review them. Ms. Riggins stated that the packet that has been review over the last few meetings was received in word form for review. She has gone through and written numbers where points needed clarification based on the commission's comments regarding the ordinance. There is a sheet with corresponding number with the clarifications that will need to be amended. Ms. Riggins plans to present the ordinance for the document at the February meeting and send it on to the City Council. The clarifications along with the word document have been attached to the minutes. Commissioner Greg Fox wanted clarification that phase 1 includes building the STEP system. Commissioner Shanks asked if the turn lane onto 41 would be completed before or after the development. Ms. Riggins stated it was a County Road and encouraged the developer to speak with the county based on a traffic study.
