EVENT RULES:

By submitting payment, you are acknowledging these rules. Space will not be reserved until payment and this registration form are received by the city. The city will honor location requests first to sponsors and then to past vendors, but all booth locations are subject to change by the city as needed in an effort to present the best possible festival atmosphere. Roads will be closed to all vehicle traffic throughout the event, including vendors; vendors arriving after their designated setup time when streets close or needing to leave before the roads are reopened will be unable to drive into the area to load/unload. Extension cords for electric service will NOT be provided; vendors paying for electric service should be prepared with at least a 100-foot, well grounded, exterior extension cord and any necessary power strips. Outside generators are not allowed; if needed, vendors must secure electrical service at the time of registration. Should electrical service become limited, the city may allow outside generators in designated areas only, and only by advance approval. Food vendors are responsible for cleanup and removal of ALL food prep materials and waste including oils. Food vendors that leave behind any such waste or general state of uncleanness will forfeit their deposit. Vendors that need to cancel their registration must do so no later than August 31; after that time, no refund will be given for cancellations. This is a rain or shine event; there is no alternate date; no refunds will be paid due to weather. Vendors are encouraged to come prepared for any potential inclement weather – rain, wind gusts, etc. Vendors agree to indemnify the City against and save it harmless from any and all claims, suits or liability for injuries to property, injuries to persons including death, and from any other claims, suits, liens, or liability on account of any act or omission of the Vendor or any of its officers, members, agents, employees, representatives, or volunteers. Indemnification shall include, but not be limited to, all attorneys' fees, expenses, and costs incurred by the City related thereto.
